The Company's exploration and environmental plans will reflect procedures that ensure:

- Compliance with all relevant environmental legislation, standards and Codes of Practice and promotion of consultation with stakeholders.
- Monitoring and measurement of our environmental impacts.
- Prevention of adverse environmental impacts and pollution in the workplace.
- The training of all workers so they understand their roles and responsibilities in achieving Dreadnought's stated aim of environmental protection.
- The regular review of targets and objectives as part of the Environmental Management System process.
- Continual improvements and prevention of pollution by means of reduced waste, conserving resources, in particular water and energy, and to seek opportunities for the recycling of waste materials.
- An effective Emergency Response Program is maintained to handle any unforeseen incidents which have the capacity to affect the environment, including appropriate corrective actions.

The Board and Executive Leadership Team have ultimate oversight for implementing environmental management and improvements, however, Dreadnought will hold all its workers and contractors accountable for their performance in accordance with this Environmental Policy.
